The NCAAOM Philanthropic Fellowship Award recognizes a member who has made a significant financial contribution to the sustainability of the organization. Individuals are selected on the basis of the value and degree of their philanthropy overall. The Philanthropic Fellowship Award is presented at the NCAAOM Annual Member Meeting.

Deadline: April 6, 2017

Selection Criteria: Nominations will be reviewed for the quality and impact of the candidate's contributions. Successful nominations will demonstrate a sustained and/or enduring contribution to the organization and profession overall.

Submissions: Nominations for the NCAAOM Philanthropic Fellowship Award should be submitted using the Philanthropic Fellowship Award form below. Each nomination involves the following:

- Name, address, phone number, and email address of the person making the nomination.
- Name of the candidate being nominated. It is NCAAOM's policy not to tell candidates who have nominated or endorsed them.
- Nomination statement: This should be a concise statement (maximum of 25 words) describing the key impact and service for which the candidate merits this award. This may describe the candidate's work in general, but should draw particular attention to the contributions that merit the award. Note that the final wording for awardees will be at the discretion of the Awards Committee.
